Logistics:

Q: I have accessibility needs; who do I connect with about ensuring I can fully participate?

Q: What time should I arrive?

A: Please aim to arrive no later than 8:30am for check-in and breakfast. The program will begin promptly at 9am.

Q: Will meals be served?

A: A full breakfast and lunch will be served, and small bites and refreshments provided throughout the day. The day will culminate in a reception with hors d'oeuvres and beverages.

Hotel:

Q: Where can I stay while visiting Philadelphia?

A: [The Inn at Penn](#) and [The Sheraton Philadelphia University City](#) are both walking distance to Huntsman Hall. We recommend booking your stay as soon as possible, as rooms may fill up closer to the event.

Transportation:

Q: I will be taking public transportation to campus. What is the best means of transport?

A: The closest trolley station lets off on 37th and Walnut Street, and the 40 bus line also stops at this intersection. Other bus lines stop in adjacent parts of campus. Additionally, there are numerous ride-sharing options in Philadelphia.

Q: I will be driving to campus. Where can I park?

Q: I will be traveling directly from the train station/airport. How far is it to campus?

A: We are a 20-25 minute walk from Amtrak's 30th Street Station, and a 20-25 minute Taxi/Uber/Lyft from the Philadelphia airport.

Accessing Huntsman Hall:

Q: Where do I enter the building?

A: Please plan to arrive at Huntsman Hall (3730 Walnut Street, Philadelphia, PA 19104) on the ground level on the Walnut Street entrance. You will need to show photo identification to the security guard there. You will then take the elevator to the 8th floor. Please note that the 8th floor is only accessible from elevators on Walnut Street side of the building.
